Cut the paper into strips and write 1-10 in Chinese, or just cut the paper into large puzzle shapes and help your child put the “puzzle” together.	Family Words Numbers Puzzle= pīntú/ 拼图

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Family Photos Scissors Glue Popsicle Sticks 	Family Stick Puppets: Attach photos of your family members to popsicle sticks and tell silly stories, create a “house” of craft paper or a shoebox, or use them as props while singing songs! <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Roll and Graph Family Words printable (included) Family Word Die Printable (included) 	Repeat the activity from Class 3 with Suzy Laoshi. Create a die with family words on it and after each roll, record that family member on the graph using a coloring tool or small token, until someone “wins” by reaching the top of the graph. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Family Photo Transparency Paper or Clear Page Protector Marker or Sharpie 	Lay a piece of transparency paper over your family photo and trace each family member. Review facial features, body parts, and family words as you trace the photo.	Review body parts, facial features, and family words.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut and match Chinese words to family members (included) 	Cut out the Chinese words and glue them down in the box underneath the matching person. Use the vocabulary section for support as needed.	Chinese Character and Vocabulary Practice
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Colored People Toys or Colored cups 	Create patterns using toy family people or colorful cups. You can even write the Chinese words on the cups and then make patterns. i.e. red = mama, blue = baba and make pattern: red blue red blue red...	Review Counting Review characters Family Words
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Toy blocks and toy people 	Build houses using blocks or toys you have. Add "people" to the houses and practice counting and asking/answering questions such as "How many people are in your home?" (Check phrases page for support).
